In 2022 this will present as 5/5 with an A level of Achievement in mathematics. 100% of students in year 3 (8 out of 8 students) who achieved close to HB in 2021 will achieve HB in year 5 in NAPLAN numeracy when tested in year 5 2023. Retain 8 HB students from year 5 2021 NAPLAN reading – in 2022 assessment in reading component of English to be 'A'.
