
#### Library

Premier's Reading Challenge forms are coming in, in bigger numbers now and very soon I will have our Premier's reading challenge honour board up in the Library Foyer.



#### eSafety Webinars for Parents and Carers

Safety on the web is a discussion I have with many parents, carers and students. Keeping children safe online is an area which all parents and carers are concerned, but only a very few feel they have the knowledge and skill-set to properly monitor it. Adults often feel out of touch or out of their depth. During May and June, eSafety.gov.au are running free webinars for parents. **The first webinar running in May is - eSaftey's guide to parental controls.** This webinar will look at how parents and carers can set up devices and apps to help keep young people safer online.

Audience: parents and carers of children aged 4-13

The webinar will cover:

- The benefits and limitations of parental controls
- How to set up iOS and Android devices for safety
- How to set up popular games and apps like YouTube and Roblox for safety
- Using family tech agreements and other parenting strategies to manage online risks
- How eSafety can help when things go wrong





### FLINDERS UNIVERSITY PSYCHOLOGY CLINIC





#### What is the Flinders University Psychology

The Flinders University Psychology Clinic (FUPC) is a clinical psychology service linked to the School of Psychology at Flinders University and is situated in the grounds of Flinders University. At FUPC postgraduate (Masters and Clinical PhD) provisional psychologists carry out assessments and therapy under supervision from a registered clinical psychologist. Our clinic also serves as a research facility and actively contributes to advances in psychological knowledge and scientifically based treatment methods.

#### Who comes to the Flinders University Psychology Clinic?

The Flinders University Psychology Clinic accepts referrals in several areas:

- . assessment and treatment of anxiety and stress in children and adolescents
- · assessment and treatment of behavioural difficulties in children
- · assessment and treatment of anxiety disorders in adults
- psycho-educational assessments of children and adolescents (testing of cognitive ability and academic achievement)

We work with children and adolescents with a range of issues including school avoidance, selective mutism, generalised anxiety, obsessive compulsive disorder, adjustment to challenging events (e.g., parental separation), perfectionism and managing stress (such as Year 12). We also work with children (and their families) where behavioural difficulties in the home or school environments are a concern. For adults, referrals for a range of anxiety disorders including generalised anxiety disorder, social phobia and specific phobias are

Fees for assessment and treatment of anxiety, stress and behavioural problems are set at \$35 for an initial intake interview (90 minutes) and \$25 per subsequent session (60 minutes). Fees for psycho-educational assessments (including initial interview, assessment, feedback session and report) are \$400 per assessment.
