

SCHOOL CARD

The Department for Education has implemented an online School Card application process. Applicants who apply for School Card assistance via an ED003A – Income Audit application form can apply online at sa.gov.au/education/schoolcard. **The DfE strongly urge you to apply this way rather than filling out a paper application.**

Paper copies of the application form are available from the finance office if required.

By completing the ED003A Application form online, notification will be emailed directly to the government school(s) where the child(ren) attend, ie. where two children attend different schools both sites will receive a copy of the application form.

You can access the online forms from any device that gets internet, including mobile devices, such as tablets and smart phones, as well as laptops and computers.

1. Once you have logged in, select the type of School Card you would like to apply for (for example 'Type A') and follow the prompts.
2. Complete all mandatory fields. You cannot proceed to the next page unless all mandatory fields are complete.
3. Once you have completed a page click on the NEXT button.
4. Once you have filled out all pages click the SUBMIT button. **Please note: if you exit the form without clicking SUBMIT your details will be lost.**
5. You can save the form, and return to complete it at another time, by clicking on the SAVE button.

Eligibility for School Card assistance is dependent upon the combined family gross income for the 2022-23 financial year being within the following School Card income limits:

2	\$72,262	\$1,390
3	\$73,530	\$1,414

After you apply, you will receive a letter in the mail advising if your application has been approved.
